



North Wasco School District K-5 Hybrid In-Person Learning Overview



SOCIAL DISTANCING



- Students will be placed in a consistent cohort (group) of less than 15 students. Students remain with this cohort of students throughout their school day.



- Classroom designs will allow for 35 square feet per person with 6 feet of spacing in between students. Students are assigned a consistent desk/seat.



- Face coverings for students and staff will be required. The District will supply a mask or face covering for anyone who needs one.



HEALTH PROTOCOLS



- Staff will provide regular cleaning and sanitizing of buses and high touch areas, such as screens, work stations, equipment, doorknobs, and restrooms throughout the school frequently and between cohort groups.



- Students wash or sanitize hands upon arrival, before/after meals, after restroom use, before/after play-ground time, and before departing each day.



- Students exhibiting symptoms at any time during the day will be sent to the isolation room and home if necessary. **Please do not send students to school with any illness.**



INSTRUCTION



- Students will receive instruction in person Mon, Tues, Thurs, and Fri in small cohorts.



- On Wednesday all students will participate in CDL with the entire class like they are currently doing.



- Students will attend school in two cohorts, A cohort students (morning) 8:00-10:30 AM or B cohort students (afternoon) 12:30-3:00 PM.

- Some classes (PE, Music, and Library) and interventions will remain virtual to limit cohort sizes. Students may be asked to bring chrome books on-site.



LOGISTICS



- Students are visually screened prior to entering the bus. Students have assigned seats that are appropriately spaced to comply with social distancing.



- Students will have a designated meeting spot for arrival and departure each day. School staff will meet students for screening. Students exhibiting symptoms will be sent to the office for isolation and further screening.



- Breakfast will be eaten in classrooms. When possible, eating outdoors will be encouraged. Recess and breaks will be with cohort groups.
